IRAQ: URGENT ACTION NEEDED

This past week, in Mosul, assassins broke into the home of friends of our Dominican family and killed the father and his two sons. The Iraqi sisters studying in the U.S. are very shook up and their Prioress, Sister Maria, has told them that the situation is very critical and the sisters living at their motherhouse are in grave danger. The friars have already left Mosul and are living elsewhere.

Eight Christians have been assassinated in Mosul in the last 10 days. Christians are fleeing by the hundreds, leaving everything except what they can carry. It is clearly the Christians who are being targeted. The elections are coming up. There are political motivations yet it is a true persecution approaching genocide. The situation has continued to deteriorate.

We ask you to ask your communities for the following actions:

1. Wear a black ribbon with your "I have family Iraq" button during Lent in solidarity with the Christians in Iraq.
 2. Invite members of the community to fast and pray, and report to the Iraq coordinating committee what you are doing.
 3. Please write a letter to the editor of your local paper. You may use pieces of the letter to the Cardinal or some of the news items that are attached in the email.
