The topics of the meeting included review of the convocation, comments from participants, budget and finance, and plans for area meetings, leadership meetings (2013 & 2014), and the 2015 Convocation and Leaders Meeting. Our days started with shared prayer and ended with opportunities to relax with the local community, including a Dominican Volunteer, Megan Rupp.

One of the members of the committee joined the meeting via Skype. Margaret Mayce NGO/UN Representative also participated in the meeting. The EC also had a conference call with the new Finance Committee of the DSC.

Convocation

The evaluations were overwhelmingly positive regarding all aspects of the Convocation. Special recognition and thanks are due to all who planned and participated in the Convocation, and to those who prayed for its success. The comments and evaluations were reviewed, and recommendations will be sent to the appropriate committees.

Mission Statement

At the Convocation we acknowledged that we are living into the Mission Statement. The Executive Committee reviewed the comments and will be forwarding them on to the Writing Committee. The method for affirming the Mission Statement will be determined at a future date.

Budget and Finance

The Executive Committee reviewed the financial statement and budget, and later discussed these with the Finance Committee on a conference call.

Site Meetings (Regional)

The Executive Committee and Margaret Mayce spent significant time fleshing out the content of the site meetings, in response to the overwhelming call from the Convocation to move forward on the question: What is the Earth Asking of Us?

A committee of volunteers has been formed to orchestrate the details of these meetings. Information will be forthcoming. The incorporation of technology is a high priority for these meetings.


