Chicago Workers' Collaborative Teams up with Dominicans

On May 23, 2013, Chuck Dahm, O.P. participated in a press conference held at the entrance to Elite Staffing, a large day labor agency in Chicago. The day labor industry is the largest industry in Illinois, and it is riddled with labor abuse such as wage theft, sexual harassment, excessive charges for transportation, racial and gender discrimination in hiring, failure to provide protective equipment, and more. The Chicago Workers Collaborative, which got its start at St. Pius V with the support of Chuck and Brendan Curran, O.P., organized the event. CWC is the premiere organization defending the rights of day laborers in Chicago. The press conference/protest was successful because the company agreed to dialogue about the seven principles of labor justice that CWC presented.




